The Stories of Pro Bono in TN

This month's stories submitted by Stef Brake, Nashville School of Law Legal Aid Society Access to Justice Extern, Spring 2018

"My first pro bono experience was during an immigration clinic held in October 2017.

"Julio" was an undocumented worker, and a few volunteers and I were responsible for his intake. When we asked why he came in that day and what he was hoping to achieve, he said, "To get a driver's license so I can drive the truck at work." It hit us all in the gut. Amazing to realize how a legal issue that may seem so basic, simple, and

easily obtainable to most is actually life changing to another."

"What I would say to a lawyer who has never done pro bono before is, "You are truly missing out." If you are in need of a pick me up, working with a pro bono client will renew your spirit. The humility and appreciation alone will remind you why you wanted to be a lawyer to begin with. In their eyes, you instantly become a super hero."

"My favorite pro bono case was during an expungement clinic held in March 2018. "Tina" had over 20 dismissed cases on her record. I sat down with her to review her file, and she felt compelled to explain how the charges came to be and how she wanted to do better. When I explained the possibility of getting the items removed and how she could, in essence, start all over again, a wave of strong and positive emotion came over her. When her tears had dried, we stayed in line together to see the judge, and it was then I understood that the true power of becoming an attorney is not guaranteeing victory, but giving someone hope in their darkest days."
